The Summer Rock Climbing Camp provides campers between the ages of 9 and 16 with an opportunity to push their abilities to a new level in a safe and fun environment. The small number of campers combined with the large number of experienced instructors provides campers with daily, intense instruction and training that is a unique experience for each camper.



Additional Activities

Each day, campers also participate in a variety of non-climbing activities that range from swimming and field sports to campfires and skits.

Director and Founder

Aleksey Shuruyev started climbing as a teenager in the Caucasus Mountains near his hometown of Krasnodar. Since then, he has had 29 years of climbing and mountaineering experience in the Caucasus, Crimea, Yosemite, US Rocky Mountains, New England and Alaska. Aleksey has put up dozens of first ascents in Yosemite, Alaska, New England and the Caucasus, some of them featured in the American Alpine Journal. A teacher by education, he has worked with children of all ages; for the past nine years, he has developed safety-conscious, well-rounded climbing and other outdoor programs for youngsters and the young at heart. His students compete at the regional, divisional, national and world levels. A number of his students have become US National Champions and US National Team members.



Instructors

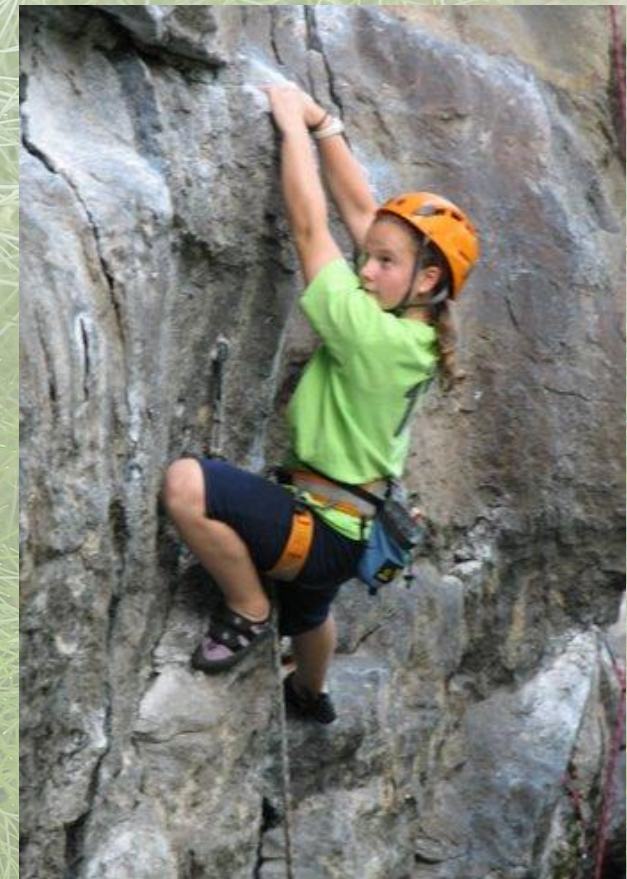
The instructors have experience climbing and competing around the world and are not only skilled rock climbers, but also coach and train kids to climb year-round.

Location

The camp is located at the Plymouth Sands Campground in Rumney, NH (roughly 2 hours from Boston). The campground is located only 10 minutes from the North-east's best sport climbing destination: Rumney. It's the perfect location for campers to challenge themselves, with over 300 routes ranging from 5.0 to 5.15. The campground also serves as a perfect home base for other nearby areas in New Hampshire.
